

# ORDINANCE No. 1908

## A BILL FOR:

AN ORDINANCE providing for the time and manner of improving EIGHTH STREET, from the West line of Maple to the East line of Cottage, TWELFTH STREET from the West line of Elm to the East line of Cottage, TWELFTH STREET from the West line of Washington Street to the East line of Vine, TWELFTH STREET from 99E to the East line of Washington Street, WALNUT STREET, between Queen Avenue and Nineteenth Avenue and EIGHTEENTH AVENUE from Maple Street to Elm, MAPLE STREET from Queen Avenue to Eighteenth Avenue, UMPUQUA STREET from the West line of Takema to the East line of Lawnridge, EIGHTH STREET from Clay to Columbus, NINTH STREET from Clay to Columbus, CLAY STREET from 8th Street to Santiam Road, BRNIE STREET from the South line of 99E to the North line of Santiam Road, ELEVENTH STREET from the East line of Liberty to the West line of Cottage Street, COLUMBUS STREET from the South line of Old Pacific Highway to North line of 99E, TENTH STREET from the East side of West Street to the West side of Cottage Street, LAWNRIIDGE STREET from 80 feet North of Umpqua Street to Fifteenth Street, HILL STREET from the South line of Sixth Street to the North line of Eighth Street and SIXTH STREET from the East line of Hill Street to the West line of Main Street, RAILROAD STREET between 1st and 7th Streets.

### THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the above named streets are to be improved in accordance with the Charter and ordinances of the City of Albany, Oregon, and the plans specifications and estimates of Harold Poling, Engineer, filed in the office of the Recorder of the City of Albany on the 10th day of June, 1948, and that said improvements consist of the following, to-wit:

1. Grading and graveling said streets.
2. Installing curbs, gutters and sidewalks, where needed.
3. Installing a proper drainage system.
4. Installing suitable hard surfacing, where necessary.

The cost of the making of said improvements shall be paid out of the funds to be collected and arising upon and out of the assessments hereafter to be made, ascertained and declared by the Council of the said City of Albany on the lots and parts of lots adjacent to said portion and particularly benefited thereby, as provided by the Charter of said City of Albany.

Said improvement shall be completed by the 16th day of October, 1948.

All bids for the making of said improvement deemed unreasonable by the Council may be rejected.

Any person, firm or corporation with whom any contract may be entered into by the City of Albany for the making of said improvements, shall, before commencing said improvements and at the time of signing such contract, make, execute and deliver to said City a good and sufficient bond with sufficient surety thereon to be approved by the Mayor of the City of Albany in a sum equal to fifty percent of the amount to be paid under such contract for the faithful performance thereof.

Section 2. If the person, firm or corporation entering into any contract with the City of Albany to make said improvements shall not complete the same within the time mentioned and specified in such contract, the City of Albany shall be deemed to suffer damages on account thereof in the amount of \$25.00 per day for each day the completion of said work is delayed beyond the time stated in such contract, which amount shall be paid by such contractor doing the work at the completion thereof unless the time of the completion of said improvements be extended by the Council.
