

BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE # 2078
ORDINANCE # 1949

AN ORDINANCE granting a salary increase to the Chief of Police and City Recorder of \$20.00 per month each effective as of September 1, 1948 to the end of the present budget year, June 30, 1949, to be paid out of the Meter Fund.

WHEREAS; the Chief of Police and City Recorder have greatly increased work and responsibilities it is desired by the Council to grant them a salary increase to compensate for the additional time and attention to the duties of their office.

WHEREAS; considerable work of each office is concerned with traffic control it is proper that this portion of the salary of each office be paid by the Meter Fund.

The people of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Chief of Police be paid an additional \$20.00 monthly salary, September 1, 1948 to June 30, 1949, chargeable to the Meter Fund.

Section 2. That the City Recorder be paid an additional \$20.00 monthly salary, September 1, 1948 to June 30, 1949, chargeable to the Meter Fund.

Section 3. Whereas, the peace, health, and safety of the people of the City of Albany are involved. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall become immediately effective upon its final passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor
