

ORDINANCE NO. 2167

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 1533 WHICH IS AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE AND SALE OF DOG LICENSES; PROVIDING FOR THE COLLECTION OF DOG LICENSE FEES IN COOPERATION WITH THE COUNTY COURT; PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF AN ADDITIONAL POLICE OFFICER TO ASSIST IN THE ENFORCEMENT OF THIS ORDINANCE; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION HEREOF AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The people of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

That Section 4. of said Ordinance No. 1533 be amended as follows:

- That \$1.00 shall be changed to read \$2.00;
- That \$2.00 shall be changed to read \$3.00.

That all other terms and conditions of the ordinance remain as written.

Whereas the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Albany require that this ordinance become immediately effective, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its final passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
