

ORDINANCE NO. 2335

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE SALEM SAND AND GRAVEL COMPANY AND THE VALLEY CONCRETE AND PIPE COMPANY, INC. FOR THE PURPOSES OF CONSTRUCTION OF CERTAIN SEWER IMPROVEMENT.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Albany did by Resolution No. 221 authorize the City Engineer to prepare plans and specifications for certain sewer improvements as set forth in Ordinance 2332, and

WHEREAS, the advertisements for bids were published in accordance with the law and bids were received, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Albany at a regular council meeting on the 12th day of March, 1952, did by motion duly seconded and passed award contract number 1 to the Valley Concrete and Pipe Company, Inc., and contract number 2 to the Salem Sand & Gravel Company.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Mayor and the City Manager of the City of Albany are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the Valley Concrete & Pipe Company, Inc., for the improvements as set forth in contract number 1 in the Engineer's plans and specifications for the same as now on file with the City Recorder, and set forth in Ordinance 2332 in the sum of \$5,471.01.

Section 2. That the Mayor and the City Manager of the City of Albany are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the Salem Sand & Gravel Company for improvements as set forth as contract number 2 in the Engineer's plans and specifications for the same as now on file with the City Recorder and set forth in Ordinance 2332 in the sum of \$34,404.80.

Section 3. Inasmuch as the provisions of this ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and its approval by the Mayor of the City of Albany.
