

ORDINANCE NO. 2521

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1999, PERTAINING TO THE LICENSING OF CERTAIN CALLERS, TRADES, AND OCCUPATIONS, SECTION 4 THEREOF.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 4 of Ordinance No. 1999 be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 4. Every person, firm, corporation, or association required by this ordinance to obtain a license to engage in any trade, business, occupation, or profession for which license is required shall pay to the City Recorder a sum of money required by this ordinance in payment thereof, together with an application for the license sought; Thereupon, the City Recorder, upon assurance that the applicant has complied with the provisions of this ordinance, shall issue the license requested; provided, however, that all applications for licenses by transients shall be referred to the council for approval prior to the issuance of a license.

Transients shall be defined for purposes of this ordinance as those persons, firms, or corporations applying for a license under this ordinance who have not been a residence in the City of Albany for the period of 90 days, prior to applying. Sponsorship, by an applicant who would otherwise be classified as a transient, by a resident person, firm, or corporation shall not alter the classification in that application and must be approved by the council."
