

ORDINANCE NO. 2524

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1960. PERTAINING TO SEWER SERVICE CHARGES.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Section 3, of Ordinance No. 1960 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 3: That the just and equitable charges aforesaid are hereby established, determined and declared to be as follows:

Class I: Single family residences \$0.75 pr. mo.  
Each apartment unit in any multiple family dwelling 0.75 pr. mo.

Class II: Commercial Establishments

- a. First two fixtures, minimum 1.00 per mo.
- b. Additional three to five fixtures, each .50 per mo.
- c. Additional six to ten fixtures, each .25 per mo.
- d. Each additional fixture thereafter .20 per mo.
- e. All schools belonging to Union High School No. 8 will be charged on an adjusted rate based upon the above less 30%. All schools belonging to School District No. 5 will be charged on an adjusted rate based upon the above less 40%.

Class III: Industrial establishments who discharge wastes into the sewer system shall be charged at the rate as defined in Class II Commercial Establishments above or at the following rate, whichever is the greater:


- a. First 500 cu. ft. at \$0.15 per 100 cu. ft.
- b. Next 1000 cu. ft. at \$0.10 per 100 cu. ft.
- c. Next 8500 cu. ft. at \$0.07½ per 100 cu. ft.
- d. Next 90,000 cu. ft. at \$0.05 per 100 cu. ft.
- e. All over 100,000 cu. ft. at \$0.02 per 100 cu. ft."
