

ORDINANCE NO. 2536

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH "NISSAN MOTOR COMPANY", FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWO POLICE CARS FROM THE NISSAN MOTOR COMPANY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Recorder did heretofore advertise for bids for two police cars for the City of Albany, and

WHEREAS, said bids were received and duly opened at the time therein set forth, and

WHEREAS, upon recommendation of the Council of the City of Albany

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


That the Mayor and City Manager of the City of Albany are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Nissan Motor Co., of Albany, Oregon for the purchase of two 1954 Ford-Four door sedans with V8 motors at the bid price for the two units in the sum of \$4394.00 less trade in allowance on two 1953 Ford Four-door sedans in the sum of \$2894.00, making a balance upon the contract of \$1500.00 and,

By this Ordinance does hereby ratify any action heretofore taken as herein provided.

Inasmuch as the passage of this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and its approval by the Mayor of the City of Albany.
