

ORDINANCE NO. 2635

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF GASOLINE WITH THE STANDARD OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA.

WHEREAS, the Recorder did heretofore advertise for bids for the purchase of GASOLINE for the City of Albany, and

WHEREAS, said bids were received and duly opened at the time set forth in the said notice, and

WHEREAS, the Council determined the bid of the STANDARD OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA to be the most favorable bid.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That the Mayor and City Manager of the City of Albany are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the STANDARD OIL COMPANY FOR the purchase of GASOLINE commencing January 1, 1956, and ending December 31, 1956, at the said Company's posted prices applicable to commercial consumer accounts, but not to exceed the sum of \$.2158 per gallon for regular and,

By this ordinance does hereby ratify any action heretofore taken as herein provided.

Inasmuch as the passage of this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and its approval by the Mayor of the City of Albany, Oregon.
