

ORDINANCE NO. 2749

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2413, SECTION II THEREOF, BY AUTHORIZING THE USE OF MULTI-OUTLET ASSEMBLIES UNDER SUPERVISION OF THE BUILDING AND ELECTRICAL INSPECTOR.

RECITALS:

1. On September 10, 1952, the Council, by Ordinance No. 2413, adopted an electrical code for the City.
2. It now appears, through technological advancement, that multi-assembly outlets are a safe installation in Fire Zone 1 and in public and semi-public buildings.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN

Section 1:

Ordinance No. 2413, Section II thereof, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section II. ADOPTION OF THE NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE

The National Electric Code, as promulgated by the National Board of Fire Underwriters and American Standards Association, and its subsequent revisions, is hereby adopted and made a part of this Ordinance as if it were herein set forth in full, with the following exception:

- a. All wiring hereinafter installed in a new structure, or repairs or replacements installed in an existing structure, within the boundaries of the Fire District No. 1, as established or as hereafter changed by proper authority, shall be installed in rigid metal conduit, except as hereafter provided.
- b. All wiring hereinafter installed in commercial buildings or in public or semi-public buildings, such as schools, churches, lodges, or buildings where the public will assemble or patronize within any part of Albany, shall be installed in rigid metal conduit, except as hereafter provided.
- c. Flexible metal conduit may be used in making connections to motors or other appliances and installations where, in the opinion of the building and electrical inspector, rigid connections would not be practical and where the length of flexible conduit does not exceed five (5) feet in length.
- d. Multi-outlet assemblies may be installed in Fire District No. 1, in public and semi-public buildings, and in commercial buildings, if, in the opinion of the Building and Electrical Inspector, such installation is safe."
