AN CRDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE DATE AND MANNER OF HOLDING A SPECIAL ELECTION IN THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, ON THE 6TH DAY OF JUNE, 1960, FOR THE PURPOSE OF BUSINITING TO THE LEGAL VOTERS OF THE CITY OF ALBANY THE FOLLOWING: (1) A SPECIAL CONTINUING FIVE YEAR TAX LEVY OF \$12,730.00 FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1960-61 AND 60.000 PER YEAR FOR EACH OF THE NEXT FOUR YEARS OUTSIDE THE 6% TAX LIMITATION, TO BE USED FOR FIRE DEPARTMENT EQUIPMENT AND PERSONNEL; (2) A SPECIAL CONTINUING FIVE YEAR TAX LEVY OF \$19,045.00 PER YEAR OUTSIDE THE 6% TAX LIMITATION, SAID MONEY TO BUSED FOR THE OPERATION OF THE PARKS DEPARTMENT; (3) A SPECIAL CONTINUING FIVE YEAR TAX LEVY OF \$6,000.00 PER YEAR OUTSIDE THE 6% TAX LIMITATION, TO BE USED FOR AN EMPLOYEE HOSPITALIZATION INSURANCE PLAN; (4) A SPECIAL CONTINUING FIVE YEAR TAX LEVY OF \$4,800.00 FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1960-61 AND \$1,250.00 PER YEAR FOR EACH OF THE NEXT FOUR YEARS OUTSIDE THE 6% TAX LIMITATION TO BE USED FOR POLICE DEPARTMENT EQUIPMENT AND PERSONNEL; (5) A SPECIAL CONTINUING FIVE YEAR TAX LEVY OF \$9,045.00 PER YEAR OUTSIDE THE 6% TAX LIMITATION, TO BE USED FOR REPLACEMENT OF EQUIPMENT, FIRE HOSE, FURNITURE, OFFICE MACHINES AND MAINTENANCE MACHINERY; (6) A SPECIAL CONTINUING FIVE YEAR TAX LEVY OF \$1,000.00 PER YEAR OUTSIDE THE 6% TAX LIMITATION, SAID MONEY TO BE USED AS A BASIS FOR CIVIL DEFENSE; (7) A SPECIAL CONTINUING FIVE YEAR TAX LEVY OF \$1,000.00 PER YEAR OUTSIDE THE 6% TAX LIMITATION, SAID MONEY TO BE USED FOR STREET LIGHTING ADDITIONS AND REPLACEMENT; (8) A SPECIAL CONTINUING FIVE YEAR TAX LEVY OF \$5,000.00 PER YEAR OUTSIDE THE 6% TAX LIMITATION TO BE USED FOR STREET LIGHTING ADDITIONS AND REPLACEMENT; (8) A SPECIAL CONTINUING FIVE YEAR TAX LEVY OF \$5,000.00 PER YEAR OUTSIDE THE 6% TAX LIMITATION TO BE USED FOR STRING AND FALL TRASH PICK-UP, SAID MEASURES TO BE SUBMITTED FOR THE VOTERS' ADOPTION OR REJECTION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

### Section 1: TIME AND MANNER OF ELECTION

In a manner provided by law and in this Ordinance, and for the purposes set forth herein a Special Election shall be held in the City of Albany, Oregon, on the 6th day of June, 1960, commencing thereon at 8:00 a.m. of said day and continuing until 8:00 p.m. of said day.

#### Section 2: VOTING PLACES

The following are hereby designated as voting places for said election:

First Ward: Maple School Second Ward: Central School Third Ward: Madison School

The judge and the Clerks shall qualify by subscribing to an Oath in the manner and form provided by law and in case any such officers shall fail to attend, then those present shall elect another to act in his place.

Section Si NOTICE OF SPECIAL ELECTION

The City Recorder shall cause Notice of said Special Election to be given

by publication thereof in a newspaper of general circulation published in the City of Albany on May 27th and June 2nd, 1960; the first publication to be within ten (10) days next proceeding the date of the Special Election. Said Notice shall eithe time, voting places and a statement of the substances of the matters to be voted upon.

#### Section 6: POSTING OF NOTICE

The City Recorder, in addition to the Notice required in Section 5 shall cause to be posted in ten (10) conspicuous places within each of the three Wards, at least ten (10) days before the date of the Special Election, Notice of the Special Election in the following form:

#### "SPECIAL ELECTION NOTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on the 6th day of June, 1960, at (location) in the Ward in the City of Albany, Oregon, a Special Election will be held referring to the people of the City of Albany for their adoption or rejection, the following Special Tax matters:

- (1) A Special Tax Levy for Fire Department Equipment and Personnel. An Act to provide a special continuing five year tax levy of \$12,730.00 for the fiscal year 1960-61 and \$6,000.00 per year for each of the next four years outside the 6% tax limitation beginning 1960-61 to provide a Fire Marshal, equipment and additional funds for volunteer firemen for Albany Fire Department.
- (2) A Special Tax Levy for Parks Department. An Act to provide for a special continuing five year tax levy of \$19,045.00 per year outside the 6% tax limitation beginning 1960-61 to provide for a continuance of the present parks program of all of the services now provided.
- (3) A Special Tax Levy for Employe Hospitalization Insurance. An Act to provide for a special continuing five year tax levy of \$6,000.00 per year outside the 6% tax limitation beginning 1960-61 to provide City employes with a health and hospitalization insurance plan.
- (4) A Special Tax Levy for Police Department Equipment and Personnel. An Act to provide for a special continuing five year tax levy of \$4,800.00 for the fiscal year 1960-61 and \$1,250.00 per year for each of the next four succeeding years, outside the 6% tax limitation beginning 1960-61 to provide the Police Department with additional and replacement of equipment and personnel.
- (5) A Special Tax Levy for Equipment Amortization. An Act to provide for a special continuing five year tax levy of \$9,045.00 per year outside the 6% tax limitation beginning 1960-61 to provide for replacement of over-age and worn-out equipment, fire hose, furniture, office machines and maintenance machinery.
- (6) A Special Tax Levy for Civil Defense. An Act to provide for a special continuing five year tax levy of \$1,000.00 per year outside the 6% tax limitation beginning 1960-61 to provide a basis for Civil Defense operation.
- (7) A Special Tax Levy for Street Lighting. An Act to provide for a special continuing five year tax levy of \$10,000.00 per year outside the 6% tax limitation beginning 1960-61 to provide for replacing existing out-deted street lights and the addition of new street lights where needed.
- (8) A Special Tax Levy for Trash Pick-Up. An Act to provide for a special continuing five year tax levy of \$5,000.00 per year outside the 6% tax limitation beginning 1960-61 to provide funds for spring and fall trash pick-up, not including garbage.

Such election to be held at 8:00 elmlock a.m. in the morning and will continue until 8:00 o'clock p.m. the evening of said day.
