

ORDINANCE NO. 2917

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF CHICAGO STREET.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Albany did, by the adoption of Resolution No. 596 at the Council meeting held on the 27th day of July 1960, set the hour as 7:15 p.m. o'clock Pacific Standard Time on August 24, 1960 as the time for hearing of objections to the proposed vacation of a portion of Chicago Street, more particularly described in the said Resolution and did in the said Resolution direct the City Recorder to publish and post notice of the said proposed vacation as required by law, and

WHEREAS, notice has been posted and published as required by law and in the said Resolution, and

WHEREAS, the said hearing on the 24th day of August 1960 was duly held and no remonstrance having been filed with the City Recorder and no persons appearing objecting to the proposed vacation.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1:

That a portion of Chicago Street more particularly described as follows:

A strip of land one foot (1') in width adjacent to the Pacific Highway right-of-way between Lot 5 of Block 4 and Lot 5 of Block 6, Bryants Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon,

be and the same is hereby vacated as a public street in the City of Albany, Oregon.
