

ORDINANCE NO. 2959

TITLE: An Ordinance providing for the date and manner of holding a special election in Lehigh Acres Subdivision and adjacent area on the 26th day of May, 1961, for the purpose of submitting to the legal voters of the said territory for their adoption or rejection a proposal to annex Lehigh Acres Subdivision and adjacent area to the City of Albany, Oregon, and declaring an emergency.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: DAY AND TIME FOR ELECTION

That in a manner provided by law and in this Ordinance and for the purpose set forth herein, a special election shall be held in Lehigh Acres Subdivision and adjacent area, Linn County, Oregon, as below described on the 26th day of May, 1961, commencing at the hour of 8 o'clock a.m. on the said day, Pacific Standard Time.

Section 2: VOTING PLACE

That the following is hereby designated as the voting place of the said election:
Jack Boylan residence, 3201 East 14th Avenue, Albany, Oregon.

Section 3: JUDGE AND CLERKS

That the Judge and Clerks of the said special election who shall supervise the election within the below described territory, shall be:

Mrs. Beatrice Boylan, Judge
Mrs. Nellie Stoko, Clerk
Mrs. Verna Weaver, Clerk

Section 4: NOTICE

The City Recorder shall cause notice of said special election to be given by publication thereof in a newspaper of general circulation within the city once a week for four (4) consecutive weeks, first date of publication to be the 28th day of April, 1961, and said notice shall state the time, voting place and description of the territory proposed to be annexed.

Section 5: POSTED NOTICES

The Recorder, in addition to the notice required in Section 4 above, shall cause to be posted in four (4) conspicuous places within the territory proposed to be annexed at least ten (10) days before the date of the special election, notices of the special election in the following form:

"SPECIAL ELECTION NOTICE"

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on the 26th day of May, 1961, at the Jack Boylan residence, 3201 East 14th Avenue, Albany, Oregon, a special election will be held concerning the proposed annexation of the following described territory to the City of Albany, to-wit:

Beginning on the East line of St. James Park Addition at a point 150 feet South of the South line of Highway 20 right-of-way; thence Southeasterly along a line which is parallel to and 150 feet Southerly from said South line of Highway 20 right-of-way to the intersection of said line with the West line of Lehigh Acres Subdivision; thence South 1°23' East 937.15 feet; thence South 43°26' East 74.60'; thence South 62°49' West 55.61 feet; thence South 88°37' West 94.0 feet to the East line of Shortridge Street; thence Southerly along said East line extended Southerly to its intersection with the North line of Queen Avenue if extended Easterly; thence Easterly along said extended North line of Queen Avenue to the West line of Interstate Freeway #5 right-of-way; thence Northerly along said

West right-of-way line extended Northerly to the Northeast corner of Lot 3, Block 6, Glendorr; thence Westerly along the North line of said Lot 3 to the Northwest corner of said lot; thence North-easterly to the Southeast corner of Lot 11, Block 11, Freeway Addition; thence following along present city limits line Westerly to the place of beginning,

which election will be held at 8 o'clock in the morning and will continue until 8 o'clock in the afternoon Pacific Standard Time of the said day.

Registered voters in said territory are invited to vote upon the proposed annexation.

Section 6: PURPOSE OF ELECTION

At the said special election, the proposed annexation of the territory described below shall be submitted to the legal voters of the said territory for their adoption or rejection as hereinafter set forth in Section 7.

Section 7: SAMPLE BALLOT

The ballot title of the proposed annexation submitted to the registered voters of the said territory shall be as follows:

"PROPOSAL TO ANNEX LEHIGH ACRES SUBDIVISION AND ADJACENT AREA TO THE CITY OF ALBANY, LINN COUNTY, OREGON.

AN ACT to annex the following described territory, to the City of Albany:

Beginning on the East line of St. James Park Addition at a point 150 feet South of the South line of Highway 20 right-of-way; thence Southeasterly along a line which is parallel to and 150 feet Southerly from said South line of Highway 20 right-of-way to the intersection of said line with the West line of Lehigh Acres Subdivision; thence South 1°23' East 937.15 feet; thence South 43°26' East 74.60'; thence South 62°49' West 55.61 feet; thence South 88°37' West 94.0 feet to the East line of Short-ridge Street; thence Southerly along said East line extended Southerly to its' intersection with the North line of Queen Avenue if extended Easterly; thence Easterly along said extended North line of Queen Avenue to the West line of Interstate Freeway #5 right-of-way; thence Northerly along said West right-of-way line extended Northerly to the Northeast corner of Lot 3, Block 6, Glendorr; thence Westerly along the North line of said Lot 3 to the Northwest corner of said lot; thence Northwesterly to the Southeast corner of Lot 11, Block 11, Freeway Addition; thence following along present city limits line Westerly to the place of beginning.
