

ORDINANCE NO. 3111

ZONE CHANGE AMENDMENTS NO. 25 AND 26 UNDER ORDINANCE NO. 2916, REZONING PORTIONS OF AN AREA SOUTH OF ALBANY AIRPORT AND ADJACENT TO U. S. HWY 20 AND GOLDFISH FARM ROAD FROM R-6 RESIDENTIAL TO C-2 LOCAL COMMERCIAL AND FROM R-6 RESIDENTIAL TO R-A MULTIPLE FAMILY ZONE.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: ZONE CHANGE AMENDMENT NO. 25

An area described as follows:

Begin. N. 89°56' W. 1059.96 ft. from the NE Corner of D.L.C. 48, T. 11 S, R. 3 W; th Sly. 400 ft.; th N. 89°56' W. 840.76 ft; th N. 1 25' W. 400 ft.; th S. 89 56' E. along North line D.L.C. 48 - 841 ft., more or less, to the place of beginning

is hereby rezoned and classified from R-6 Residential to C-2 Local Commerical Zone, and this amendment shall be known as Zone Change Amendment No. 25.

Section 2: ZONE CHANGE AMENDMENT NO. 26

An area described as follows:

Beg. N. 89°56' W. 1059.96 ft. and Sly 400 ft. from the NE Corner of D.L.C. 48, T. 11 S., R 3W; th Sly 939.42 ft; th N. 89°56' W. 1106.46 ft; th Nly 101.72 ft.; th S. 89°56'E. 265.64 ft; th N. 1°25' W. 842.5 ft; th S. 89°56' E. 840.76 ft. to the place of beginning

is here by rezoned and classified from R-6 Residential to R-A Multiple Family Zone, and this amendment shall be known as Zone Change Amendment No. 26.

Section 3: A copy of this zone change amendment shall be filed in the office of the City Recorder of the City of Albany and the number of the amendments shall be noted on the official zoning map of the City of Albany.
