

ORDINANCE NO. 3157

TITLE: An Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 1368, Section 7, thereof, pertaining to license fees for dance halls, providing for an annual license only and requiring only the licenses of those places that are operated as a public dance hall for profit purposes.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: AMENDED


Section 7 of Ordinance No. 1368 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 7. LICENSE FEE. Any person, clubs, societies, association, corporation or their officers and agents or employees giving or conducting dances for profit which are open to the public shall procure a license from the City Recorder. All licenses will be issued on an annual basis beginning January 1st of each year and if application is made within the first three months of the calendar year, the license fee shall be \$30.00; if made between the first day of the fourth month and the last day of the sixth month in the year, the license fee shall be \$22.50; if made between the first day of the seventh month and the last day of the ninth month in the year, the license fee shall be \$15.00; if made after the first day of the tenth month in any year, the license fee shall be \$7.50.

Any dance, the net proceeds of which are given are to be used for benevolent, charitable or public purposes, shall not be deemed to be given for profit with the meaning of this Ordinance, then in such cases no license fee shall be required therefore."


