

ORDINANCE NO. 3205

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF PINE STREET BETWEEN BLOCKS 31 AND 32, RODGERSDALE ADDITION TO THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Albany, did, by adoption of Resolution No. 875, City of Albany Resolutions, at the Council meeting held on the 9th day of June, 1965, set the hour of 7:15 p.m. o'clock on July 14, 1965, as the time for hearing of objections to the proposed vacation of a portion of Pine Street between Blocks 31 and 32, Rodgersdale Addition, as hereinafter described, and did direct the City Recorder to publish and post notice of the said proposed vacation as required by law, and

WHEREAS, the said notice has been posted and published as required by law, and

WHEREAS, the said hearing on the 14th day of July, 1965, was duly held and parties were given an opportunity to be heard and Council being fully informed,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That a portion of Pine Street between Blocks 31 and 32, Rodgersdale Addition to the City of Albany, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at $\frac{3}{4}$ " iron rod which is the Southeast Corner of Lot 4, Block 31, Rodgersdale Addition to the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon; thence running South $86^{\circ}16'$ East 50.21 feet to a $\frac{3}{4}$ " iron rod; thence North $1^{\circ}36'$ West 109.93 feet to a $\frac{1}{2}$ " iron rod; thence along the arc of a curve to the right which has a radius of 45.0 feet for a distance of 53.01 feet to a $\frac{1}{2}$ " iron rod; thence South $1^{\circ}36'$ East 96.15 feet to the place of beginning.

be and the same is hereby vacated as a public street in the City of Albany, Oregon.
