

ORDINANCE NO. 3212

AN ORDINANCE VACATING OAK STREET BETWEEN 6<sup>th</sup> AND 7<sup>th</sup> AVENUES IN THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Albany, did, by adoption of Resolution No. 883, City of Albany Resolutions, at the Council meeting held on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of July, 1965, set the hour of 7:15 p.m. o'clock on August 11, 1965, as the time for hearing of objections to the proposed vacation of Oak Street between 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> Avenues, as hereinafter described, and did direct the City Recorder to publish and post notice of the said proposed vacation as required by law, and

WHEREAS, the said notice has been posted and published as required by law, and

WHEREAS, the said hearing on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of August, 1965, was duly held and parties were given an opportunity to be heard and the Council being fully informed,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Oak Street between 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> Avenues in the City of Albany be and the same is hereby vacated as a public street and thoroughfare in the City of Albany, Oregon.
