

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF A STREET COMMONLY KNOWN AS "D" STREET, CITY OF ALBANY, LINN COUNTY, OREGON

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Albany, did, by adoption of Resolution No. 1111, City of Albany Resolutions, at the Council meeting held on the 10th day of July, 1968, set the hour of 7:15 o'clock on August 14, 1968, as the time for hearing of objections to the proposed vacation of a portion of a street commonly known as "D" Street, as hereinafter described, and did direct the City Recorder to publish and post notice of the said proposed vacation as required by law, and

WHEREAS, the said notice has been posted and published as required by law, and

WHEREAS, the said hearing on the 14th day of August, 1968, was duly held and parties were given an opportunity to be heard and Council being fully informed,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the portion of a street more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a pt on the S line of Queen Ave., said pt being N 86° 59' E 2238.72' and S 0°52'30" E 30.02' from the NW cor of the Isaac Hutchins D.L.C. #85, T 11 S., R. 4W, W.M.; and running th Wly along sd S line of Queen Ave. 26.10' to the NE cor of Block 1, Pipe's South Albany Addition; th Sly along the E li of sd block, 125.8 ft., more or less, to the W right of way line of Pacific Blvd, th NELY, along sd right of way line 46.83 ft., more or less, to its intersection with the extension of the West line of the 4th parcel described in Book 281, page 102, Linn County, Oregon, Deed Records; th N 0°52'30" E, along said W line extension, 86.73 ft. to the place of beg (commonly known as "D" Street in title)

be and the same is hereby vacated as a public street in the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon.
