

ORDINANCE NO. 3431

AN ORDINANCE VACATING THAT PORTION OF 18TH AVENUE BETWEEN FERRY STREET AND BROADALBIN STREET IN THE CITY OF ALBANY, RESERVING AN EASEMENT FIVE FEET ON EITHER SIDE OF EXISTING SEWER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Albany, did, by adoption of Resolution No. 1172, City of Albany Resolutions, at the Council meeting held on the 23rd day of April, 1969, set the hour of 7:15 p.m. o'clock on May 28, 1969, as the time for hearing of objections to the proposed vacation of a portion of 18th Avenue between Ferry Street and Broadalbin Street, as hereinafter described, and did direct the City Recorder to publish and post notice of the said proposed vacation as required by law, and

WHEREAS, the said notice has been posted and published as required by law, and

WHEREAS, the said hearing on the 28th day of May, 1969, has been duly held and parties were given an opportunity to be heard and the Council being fully informed,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That portion of 18th Avenue between Ferry Street and Broadalbin Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, be and the same is hereby vacated except there is hereby reserved an easement of five feet on either side of existing sewer line for purposes of repair of sewer.

Section 3: Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the City of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
