

ORDINANCE NO. 3570

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE VACATING PORTIONS OF STREETS: RIVER AVENUE
FROM GEARY TO ALCO STREETS, CHICAGO STREET FROM RIVER TO LINN
LINN AVENUE FROM CHICAGO TO GEARY STREETS

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Albany, did, by adoption of Resolution No. 1307, City of Albany Resolutions, at the council meeting held on the 14th day of April, 1971, set the hour of 7:15 p.m. o'clock on the 26th day of May, 1971, as the time for hearing of objections to the proposed vacation of portions of River Avenue from Geary to Alco Streets, Chicago Street from River to Linn Avenue, Linn Avenue from Chicago to Geary Streets as hereinafter described, and did direct the City Recorder to publish and post notice of the said proposed vacation as required by law, and

WHEREAS, the said notice has been posted and published as required by law in the said Resolution, and

WHEREAS, a hearing was held on the 26th day of May, 1971, and no remonstrance was filed with the City Recorder and no persons appearing objecting to the proposed vacation of streets, now, therefore,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1:

That the portions of streets:


River Avenue, from Geary to Alco Streets
Chicago Street, from River Avenue to Linn Avenue
Linn Avenue, from Chicago to Geary Streets

EXCEPTING an easement of 16 ft. in width for utility purposes,
are hereby vacated.
