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ORDINANCE NO. 4318

TITLE: ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 5.40.020 OF THE ALBANY MUNICIPAL CODE, ESTABLISHING A FEE FOR SEWAGE OF MATERIALS DUMPED BY SEPTIC TANK CLEANING TRUCKS AT THE SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Section 5.40.020 of the Albany Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

"5.40.020 User Fee. It is hereby established a fee of one and one-half cents per gallon for all materials deposited from septic tank cleaning trucks delivered and deposited for treatment in the sewage treatment plants."

SECTION 2: Said septic tank dumping fee shall be reviewed annually during July and adjusted proportionately to any future increases or decreases in the domestic sewer use fee.

SECTION 3: EMERGENCY CLAUSE: Inasmuch as the peace, health, and safety of the people of the City of Albany are involved an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect when it is passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor.
