

ORDINANCE NO. 4604

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ALBANY MUNICIPAL CODE SECTIONS 7.28.100 AND 7.28.102, INTOXICATING BEVERAGES.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Albany Municipal Code Sections 7.28.100 and 7.28.102 are amended to read as follows:

7.28.100 Intoxicating beverages--General. No person in a park shall:

(1) ~~Parks. Alcoholic Content~~

Bring or drink alcoholic beverages with **the exception of beer and wine** an ~~alcoholic content of more than five percent by volume~~ at any time in the park;

(2) Buildings.

No Bring or drink alcoholic beverages are allowed in city-owned buildings **except by a permit issued in accordance with Section 7.28.104 through Section 7.28.106.** at any time

7.28.102 Intoxicating beverages--Prohibition--Bryant Park and Bowman Park.

It is unlawful for any person to possess an alcoholic beverage in Bryant Park and Bowman Park **without a special permit.** For the purpose of Sections 7.28.102 through 7.28.108 of the Albany Municipal Code, an alcoholic beverage is any beverage having an alcoholic content of more than one-half of one percent of volume.
