ORDINANCE NO. 4925

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ALBANY MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 7.28, PARK REGULATIONS, PROVIDING FOR THE PROHIBITION OF INTOXICATING BEVERAGES AT ELEANOR PARK AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>: Albany Municipal Code Chapter 7.28, Park Regulations, is hereby amended to read as follows:

7.28.102 Intoxicating beverages--Prohibition--Bryant Park, Bowman Park, Eleanor Park, and Monteith Riverpark. It is unlawful for any person to possess an alcoholic beverage in Bryant Park, Bowman Park, Eleanor Park, and Monteith Riverpark without a special permit. For the purpose of Sections 7.28.102 through 7.28.108 of the Albany Municipal Code, an alcoholic beverage is any beverage having an alcoholic content of more than one-half of one percent by volume.

<u>Section 2</u>: <u>Emergency Clause</u>. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the citizens of the city of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist; and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council.
