ORDINANCE NO.	5604
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AN ORDINANCE WITHDRAWING TERRITORY FROM THE ALBANY RURAL FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT LOCATED ON THE WEST SIDE OF THREE LAKES ROAD AND SOUTH OF 18TH AVENUE (LINN COUNTY ASSESSOR'S MAP NOS. 11S-03W-09D, TAX LOTS 1107, 1109, AND 1112) CONTAINING APPROXIMATELY 4.3 ACRES MORE OR LESS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Albany City Council on January 12, 2005, proclaimed the annexation of territory by adoption of Ordinance No. 594 and described in Exhibit A attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, the Albany City Council set a date for a public hearing concerning the withdrawal of said territory from the Albany Rural Fire Protection District (ARFD); and

WHEREAS, notices of said public hearing were published and posted in the manner and for the time prescribed by law and on January 12, 2005, the Albany City Council did hold a public hearing during which time interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard on this matter; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, following said public hearing, determined that the withdrawal of territory from the ARFD is in the best interests of the citizens of Albany.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>: The following described real property to-wit (see attached Exhibit A) is hereby proclaimed to be withdrawn from the Albany Rural Fire Protection District.

<u>Section 2</u>: The City Recorder shall, within 10 days of the effective date of this ordinance, file a copy of the ordinance with the County Assessor of Linn County, Secretary of State of the State of Oregon, State of Oregon Department of Revenue, and the Albany Rural Fire Protection District.

<u>Section 3:</u> Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the City of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist; and this ordinance will be in full force and effect immediately upon passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.

EXHIBIT A LEGAL DESCRIPTION FILE AN-C8-04

Beginning at a point North 0° 17' East 608.5 feet from the Southeast corner of the Lawndale Subdivision, said point also being described as the Northwest corner of that tract conveyed to Clara M.
