AN ORDINANCE WITHDRAWING TERRITORY FROM THE ALBANY AND TANGENT RURAL FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICTS LOCATED ON THE WEST SIDE OF COLUMBUS STREET SE AND ON THE NORTH AND SOUTH SIDES OF ELLINGSON ROAD SE (LINN COUNTY ASSESSOR'S MAP NO. 11 S-03W-29, TAX LOT 300) CONTAINING APPROXIMATELY 110 ACRES MORE OR LESS.

WHEREAS, the Albany City Council on July 13, 2005, proclaimed the annexation of territory by adoption of Ordinance No. 5623 and described in Exhibits A and B attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, the Albany City Council set a date for a public hearing concerning the withdrawal of said territory from the Albany and Tangent Rural Fire Protection Districts; and

WHEREAS, notices of said public hearing were published and posted in the manner and for the time prescribed by law and on July 13, 2005, the Albany City Council did hold a public hearing during which time interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard on this matter; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, following said public hearing, determined that the withdrawal of territory from the Fire Districts is in the best interests of the citizens of Albany.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:
Section 1: The following described real property to-wit (see attached Exhibits A and B for legal descriptions and maps) is hereby proclaimed to be withdrawn from the Albany and Tangent Rural Fire Protection Districts.

Section 2: The City Recorder shall, within 10 days of the effective date of this ordinance, file a copy of the ordinance with the County Assessor of Linn County, Secretary of State of the State of Oregon, State of Oregon Department of Revenue, the Albany Rural Fire Protection District and the Tangent Rural Fire Protection District.
