

RESOLUTION NO. 418

WHEREAS, the Boxing and Wrestling Commission of the City of Albany has received during the fiscal years 1955-56 and 1956-57 the total sum of \$1842.16 as receipts from wrestling matches held in Albany, and

WHEREAS, the distribution of said funds is required by State Statute to be distributed among the Veterans Organizations and the City of Albany for charitable purposes on the basis of 60% to the Veterans Organizations and 40% to the City, and

WHEREAS, certifications have been received from the following Veterans Organizations as to their membership, June 15, 1957:

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that 60% of the total receipts of the Boxing and Wrestling Commission be apportioned among the Veterans Organizations as follows:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City share of 40% in the amount of \$736.86 be transferred to the Swimming Pool Sinking Fund as provided by Ordinance No. 2571, City of Albany Ordinances.
