

R E S O L U T I O N N O . 5 0 1

BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor be authorized to accept deeds from Charles C. Curry and Lucile Curry and Marvin Carlson and Dorothy Carlson and the easement from Marvin Carlson and Dorothy C. Carlson. All instruments dated October 3, 1958 and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point which is S. 79 degrees 05' W. 127 feet from an iron pipe at the Northwest corner of Lot 5, Block 2 of Prices Second Addition to Linn County, Oregon; thence S. 4 degrees 14' E. to a point on the Southerly line of the old Railroad property as conveyed to Charles C. Curry and Lucile P. Curry by Deed Record Vol. 149 at page 31, Linn County Deed Records; thence N. 72 degrees 38' E. 35 feet along the Southerly line of said Railroad right of way line to the center line of Periwinkle Creek; thence Northerly along the center line of said Creek to a point which bears N. 79 degrees 05' W. 40 feet from the point of beginning; thence 40 feet to the point of beginning.

A portion of that property described in Book 260 at Page 345 of Deed Records of Linn County described as follows:

Beginning at a $\frac{1}{2}$ " iron rod which is S. 79 degrees 05' W. 47 feet from an iron pipe at the Northwest corner of Lot 5, Block 2 of Prices Second Addition to Linn County, Oregon; thence S. 79 degrees 05' W. 40 feet to the centerline of Periwinkle Creek; thence Southerly along the center line of said Creek to a point on the Southerly line of the old Railroad property as conveyed to Charles C. Curry and Lucile P. Curry by Deed Record Vol. 149, page 31, Linn County Deed Records; thence N. 72 degrees 38' East along the Southerly line of said property 45 feet to a $\frac{1}{2}$ " iron rod; thence N. 4 degrees 14' W. 442.54 feet to the point of beginning.

Beginning S. 81 degrees 02' W. 25 feet from the Northwest corner of Lot 8, Block 1 of Price's Second Addition to Linn County, Oregon; thence S. 9 degrees 12' E. 50 feet.
