

RESOLUTION NO. 1132


WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the City Council that the Southern Pacific Railroad Company has requested permission to discontinue operation of its passenger train referred to as the Cascade, and

WHEREAS, the City of Albany is vitally interested in railroad service to its citizens and the Cascade serves the City of Albany for both north bound and south bound traffic, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Albany that a record of vigorous opposition to the discontinuance of service of the Cascade be made. Be it further

RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the Public Utilities Commissioner of the State of Oregon, to the Interstate Commerce Commission and to the Southern Railroad Company.
