RESOLUTION NO. 1807

WHEREAS, the Albany Parking and Safety Commission has met for study on the following items and after due deliberation recommends that the Albany City Council take action on the following,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Albany City Council that the following recommendations be adopted and implemented:

1. Prohibit parking for 20 feet from the end of the curb radius on the following streets where they intersect with Queen Avenue.

1. Park Terrace

4. Madison

7. Tudor Way

2. Thurston

5. Jefferson

8. Main

3. Powell

6. Jackson

- 2. Prohibit parking on Lafayette Street from the end of the curb radius for 20 feet on the east and 40 feet on the west where the street intersects with Queen Avenue.
- 3. That Dead End signs be placed on Locust Place south of South Shore Drive, 33rd Avenue east of Fir Oaks Drive and on Fir Oaks Drive north of 33rd Avenue.
- 4. Prohibit parking for a distance of 150 feet north of the railroad crossing on the west side of Marion Street.
- 5. That the Bus Stop and No Parking zone at the southwest corner of 4th and Ferry be rescinded and that one parking stall be maintained and designated for two-hour parking.
- 6. Prohibit parking on the south side of 28th Avenue for 15 feet west of the bus entrance driveway into the Free Methodist Church.
- 7. Rescind the Loading Zone on the east side of Washington Street between 1st and Water Avenue and to allow two-hour parking.
- 8. That the City Manager be given the power to exercise the prohibition on parking up to 20' in length at any street intersection where it is deemed necessary to maintain safe operating conditions for pedestrians and vehicles.
