RESOLUTION NO. 1814

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon that there shall be initiated such proceedings as are necessary to vacate a street right-of-way in the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, which is more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

A portion of Railroad Street lying immediately to the north of Water Avenue and located between blocks 100 and 107 of Hackleman's Addition which is 66 feet in width and approximately 90 feet in length, extending north of the Willamette River.

The Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby directed to give notice of a public hearing on the proposed said vacation of easement as above described to be held in the Council Chambers at the City Hall, Albany, Oregon, on the 22nd day of September, 1976, at the hour of 7:15 p.m. o'clock by publication of notice thereof once a week for four consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation within the City of Albany and by posting notice thereof at each end of the proposed vacation and at two places within the area of the proposed vacation, within five days of first publication date, said notice to set forth the time, place and purpose of said hearing and to contain a description of the street proposed to be vacated.
