WHEREAS, the Traffic Safety Commission has met for study on the following matters and recommends that the following action be taken,

NOW, THEREFOR, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Albany, Oregon that:

- Resolution 1807 be amended to give the City Manager the power to exercise the prohibition of parking up to 30 feet in length at any street intersection where it is deemed necessary to maintain safe operating conditions for pedestrians and vehicles (resolution 1807 allows only twenty feet).
- 2) Parking be prohibited for one parking space on the west side of Ellsworth, north of the alley between 3rd and 4th Avenue.
- 3) A two hour parking zone be established on the west side of Ellsworth Street between 3rd and 4th Avenues.
- Parking be prohibited on the north side of 7th Avenue between Geary and Chicago Streets and for twenty feet on the south side of 7th Avenue at its intersection with Geary Street.
- 5) Parking be prohibited on the northwesterly side of Pacific Boulevard from Albany Avenue to the Cox Creek bridge abutment except for emergency situations.
