# RESOLUTION NO. 2501

WHEREAS, the Construction Fees Review Task Force recommended an increase in building permit fees for residential and commercial construction to City Council at the December 28, 1983 meeting.

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2462 adopted fees for residential new construction and remodeling and commercial remodeling.

WHEREAS, the December 28, 1983 report recommended an increase in commercial construction permit fees based on valuation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Albany City Council that building permit fees for commercial construction be based on valuation as outlined in the following fee schedule.

## Plumbing Permit Fees

#### Individual Fixture Fees

Except that a minimum inspection fee of \$25 shall be charged for each new building or building addition in which any fixture is located or to which any fixture is attached, and a minimum fee of \$10 shall apply for revision or alteration of plumbing within an existing building, the following fees shall be charged for inspection of the following fixtures:

Additional Miscellaneous Fees and Refunds:

(a) Fifteen dollars (\$15) per hour for each hour or any part thereof.(b) A fifteen dollar (\$15) reinspection fee shall be charged for inspection of

violations found by the Building Official after the second inspection.

(c) A partial refund of fees may be made by the Building Official upon written request of the permit holder within sixty (60) days from the date the permit was issued and prior to commencement of any work authorized by the permit. A service charge of ten dollars (\$10) will be retained by the Building Official.

(d) The fee to any person or governmental agency for specially requested

inspections or surveys shall be \$15 per hour or any portion thereof.
