INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT

This agreement is entered into this 20th day of November, 1985, by and between the City of Albany, Oregon, hereafter referred to as "City" and Linn County, Oregon, hereafter referred to as "County".

WHEREAS, "City" is applying for funds from the Oregon Public Works Infrastructure Program to help finance the extension of water and sewer service to Tax Lots 11S-3W-16-701 and 11S-3W-16-713 located outside the city limits but within the "City" Urban Growth Boundary, and

WHEREAS, such water and sewer service will allow the existing business (Canfor Lumber) to remain at that location, and

WHEREAS, both "City" and "County" find that Oregon Public Works Infrastructure Program funding and the extension of water and sewer service to said Tax Lots will positively impact the local economy.

NOW, THEREFORE, both the "City" and "County" mutually agree as follows:

1. The "City" shall be the responsible agency named on the grant application, and if a grant is awarded, the "City" shall be responsible for administration of the project.
2. Both "City" and "County" will work cooperatively in an effort to secure a grant and implement the extension of water and sewer service to the above described property.




