

RESOLUTION NO. 2706

WHEREAS, the City of Albany, in cooperation with Linn County, advertised for bids for concrete work to be performed in the course of construction of the Albany Police Department Building, and

WHEREAS, bids for the construction work in question were received on July 28, 1987, and examined by the project manager, Kitchell-CEM, and


WHEREAS, it has been determined that the apparent low bidder, Dale Ramsey, made a material error in his bid and that the remaining bidder, Marion Construction, proposes to do the work at a price substantially in excess of the engineers estimate, and

WHEREAS, based upon the foregoing the City of Albany finds that the work in question is likely to be performed at the lowest possible cost to the public if all bids are rejected.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the City of Albany hereby rejects all bids for concrete work on the Albany Police Station.

The City further resolves that the work in question be re-advertised for bid.
