

RESOLUTION NO. 2742

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the people of the City of Albany, that certain street improvements be reassessed to properties receiving a direct benefit, and

WHEREAS, one property now annexed to the City of Albany is subject to reassessment for the cost of construction of 34th Avenue from Pacific Boulevard to Marion Street, and

WHEREAS, this procedure, as described in ORS 223.410 through 223.485, be followed in the manner described therein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Albany City Council that,

1. Notification as required by ORS 223.430 and ORS 223.435 be made upon adoption of this resolution as prescribed by ORS 223.425.
2. A time and place be appointed in the notice for the Council to hear any and all objections.
3. An ordinance be prepared for the purpose of reassessing the costs for street improvements benefiting parcel 11-3W-18C-100.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Albany City Council hereby directs calling a public hearing for Wednesday, December 23, 1987 at 7:15 p.m.
