A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE ALBANY PUBLIC LIBRARY FOUNDATION TO APPLY FOR A HERITAGE GRANT FROM THE OREGON HERITAGE COMMISSION TO RESTORE THE EXTERIOR OF THE HISTORIC DOWNTOWN CARNEGIE LIBRARY.


WHEREAS, the City Council approved \$45,000 in the Fiscal Year 2001/2002 Capital Improvement Program to restore the Downtown Carnegie Library; and

WHEREAS, The Oregon Heritage Commission provides matching funds for projects that preserve, interpret, or increase public access to Oregon's heritage resources; and

WHEREAS, on September 13, 2000, the City Council passed Resolution 4336 to show support and encouragement for the Albany Public Library Foundation's application for grants to repair and renovate Albany's historic Downtown Carnegie Library.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council authorizes the Albany Public Library Foundation to apply for a Heritage Grant from the Oregon Heritage Commission to restore the exterior of the Downtown Carnegie Library.
