

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF ALBANY TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION FOR PEDESTRIAN/BICYCLE GRANT FUNDS AND A COMMITMENT TO PROVIDE A LOCAL MATCH.

WHEREAS, the Oregon Department of Transportation has grant funds available for pedestrian and bicycle projects; and


WHEREAS, a receipt of these funds will allow the City to construct sidewalk improvements on Highway 20 between Springhill Road and North Albany Road; and

WHEREAS, construction of sidewalk along this section of Highway 20 will connect to existing pedestrian facilities and fill in a missing link between downtown Albany and the residents of North Albany; and

WHEREAS, this Bicycle/Pedestrian grant application will request \$177,000 for construction of pedestrian improvements on Lyon Street and Ellsworth Street and the City of Albany's local match will be approximately \$53,000.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Albany approves and endorses the submittal of a grant application to ODOT for the purpose of sidewalk construction on Highway 20 between Springhill Road and North Albany Road.

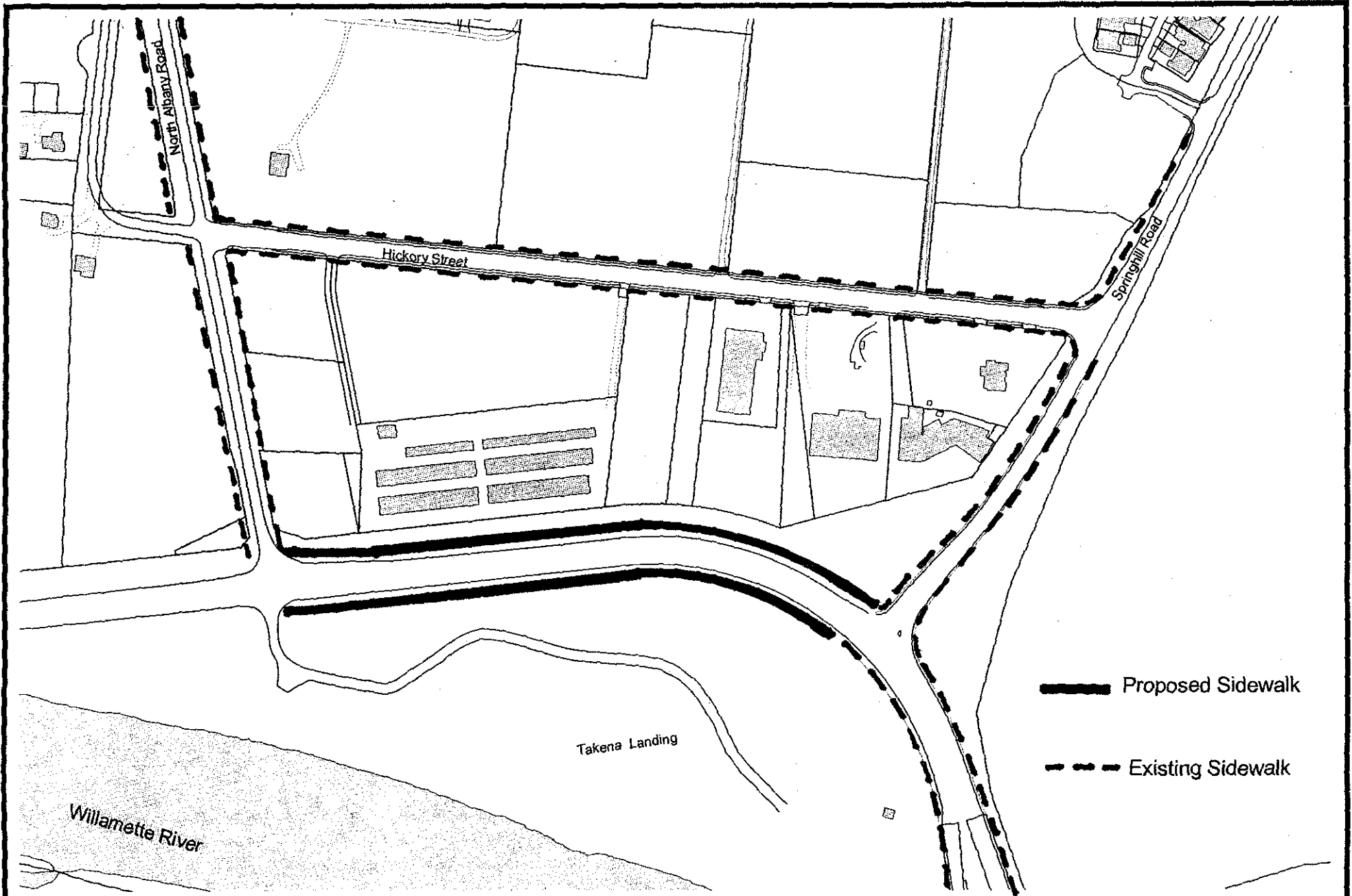
