

RESOLUTION NO. 5337

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ALBANY BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN ADVISORY COMMISSION TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE ALLIANCE FOR COMMUNITY TRAFFIC SAFETY (ACTS) OREGON FOR A TRAFFIC SAFETY MINI-GRANT.

WHEREAS, the Alliance for Community Traffic Safety in Oregon is administering a Building Safer Communities Mini-Grant program for the Oregon Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, said grant program is intended to provide funds to local agencies for programs to improve traffic safety in their communities; and

WHEREAS, Albany Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Commission, the Greater Albany Public School District, and the Bicycle Transportation Alliance collaborate to provide a bicycle education program for local 5th grade students; and

WHEREAS, that program involves the need to provide for secure storage and transportation of a bicycle fleet; and

WHEREAS, purchase of an enclosed trailer would allow for the secure storage and transportation for bicycles used for the bicycle education program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Albany approves and endorses the submittal of a grant application to ACTS Oregon in the amount of \$5,000 to fund the acquisition of an enclosed trailer to be used for the storage and transportation of bicycles used in the local bicycle education program.
