

RESOLUTION NO. 5400

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A GRANT FROM THE OREGON STATE HISTORIC PRESERVATION OFFICE (203-40-5048).

WHEREAS, the City of Albany has established a historic preservation program that includes public education, assistance, survey and inventory, and regulatory components; and

WHEREAS, the City would like to continue to provide public education, to include newsletters, workshops, and preservation activities and awards;

WHEREAS, the City would like to continue consultant work on a potential expansion of the Monteith National Register Historic District boundary; and


WHEREAS, the City would like to continue a matching grant program for rehabilitation projects for residential properties listed in the National Register District; and

WHEREAS, the City has annually applied for, and has been awarded, grant funds from the State Historic Preservation Office to assist in Albany's preservation program; and

WHEREAS, the required local match of 50 percent consists of the following: in-kind staff time by a planner who spends a portion of her time overseeing the preservation program and project rehabilitation money from residents awarded matching grants.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Albany City Council that it does hereby accept this Certified Local Government Grant in the amount of \$15,850 from the State of Oregon Historic Preservation Office, Parks and Recreation Department. The grant provides funds for workshops, programs, and newsletters to educate the public about maintaining and rehabilitating historic buildings. It also provides funds for work toward possible expansion of the Monteith Historic District.
