

RESOLUTION NO. 6044

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF ALBANY TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE OREGON DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE FLEXIBLE FUNDING PROGRAM AND A COMMITMENT TO PROVIDE THE REQUIRED LOCAL MATCH.

WHEREAS, the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) has grant funding available to help Oregon communities develop non-highway projects that include pedestrian and transit improvements; and

WHEREAS, Gibson Hill Road is an important arterial street in North Albany linking residents with schools and shopping areas; and

WHEREAS, Gibson Hill road currently lacks pedestrian and transit stop improvements; and

WHEREAS, the Albany City Council supports the construction of pedestrian and transit stop improvements on Gibson Hill Road and is willing to provide a local match of up to \$298,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Albany approves and endorses the submittal of a grant application to ODOT Flexible Funds Program for the purpose of funding design and construction of sidewalk and transit stop improvements on Gibson Hill Road.
