A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF ALBANY PARKS & RECREATION DEPARTMENT TO APPLY FOR, AND IF AWARDED, ACCEPT A SENIOR CORPS FOSTER GRANDPARENT PROGRAM GRANT FROM CORPORATION FOR NATIONAL AND COMMUNITY SERVICE (CNCS), TO PROVIDE ONE-ON-ONE MENTORING FOR AT RISK YOUTH, APPROPRIATING FUNDS AND AUTHORIZING THE PARKS AND RECREATION DIRECTOR TO SIGN THE GRANT AGREEMENT AND RELATED DOCUMENTS.

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Department submitted a grant application in the amount of \$147,566 for one-on-one mentoring for at risk youth; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to participate in this grant program to the greatest extent possible as a means of providing needed opportunities for at risk youth and limited income seniors; and

WHEREAS, the acceptance of this grant award will pay for staff, program operations, and support limited income senior volunteers; and

WHEREAS, the required funds for this project will be included in the 2011-2012 Annual Budget;

WHEREAS, the City of Albany applies and if awarded, accepts this Senior Corps Grant in the amount of \$147,566; and the following appropriations be made for the Fiscal Year 2011-2012.

WHEREAS, Oregon Local Budget Law provides that expenditures in the year of receipt of grants, gifts, bequests or devices transferred to the local government in trust for a specific purpose may be made after enactment of a resolution or ordinance authorizing the expenditure (ORS 294.326(3)).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Director of Parks and Recreation is authorized to apply and if awarded, sign the grant agreement and related documents.
