A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING FORENSIC LAB EQUIPMENT FROM THE OREGON DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE (DOJ)

WHEREAS, the Oregon DOJ received a one-time surplus of funds and is offering these funds to purchase equipment for local agencies to use in the investigation of internet crimes against children (ICAC); and

WHEREAS, Albany police department (APD) staff selected a Netgear server for digital file storage; and

WHEREAS, the need for digital file storage is increasing due to the volume of cybercrime tips received; and

WHEREAS, ICAC is a local, state, national, and worldwide problem that we all must work to combat; and

WHEREAS, Oregon local budget law provides that expenditures in the year of receipt of grants, gifts, bequests, or devices transferred to local government in trust for a specific purpose may be made after enactment of a resolution or ordinance authorizing the expenditure (ORS 294.326(3)).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Albany City Council that the police department is approved and authorized to receive equipment in the amount of \$4,339 from the Oregon DOJ.
