BUSINESS FROM THE PUBLIC

Eric Ikenouye, Library Director, shared how the Albany Public Library incorporates public art in their facilities. Ikenouye shared about their need to inventory their permanent collection, possible changes to the permanent collection, and willingness to have assistance in finding rotating artists. Brief discussion of possible partnership ideas that include an art sale at the fall Friends of the Library book sale with proceeds to fund new public art for City facilities.

Dant to purchase and coordinate refreshments for the April reception. All commissioners are eligible to display works in the April Commissioners' Show.
