

Ordinance No. 96

An ordinance relating to entering City Attorneys fee as part of judgment against persons convicted of violation of City ordinances.

Be it ordained by the Common Council of the City of Albany:

Section 1. That the City Recorder, in all cases where persons are convicted before him, either by the Court or Jury trial, for violation of City ordinances, shall enter up as part of the judgment against the defendant the costs of the prosecution, including five dollars as attorney fee.

Section 2. This ordinance to be in force from and after five days after its publication.
