

## Ordinance No. 104

Relating to City Police

Be it ordained by the Common Council  
of the City of Albany

Section 1. That <sup>whenever</sup> any person in the City of Albany shall become an habitual or common drunkard the Common Council shall on the petition of five or more citizens of the City declare every such person a common drunkard and thereafter it shall be unlawful for any person in said City to sell give or allow any such drunkard to have, take or drink any strong liquor or any drink whatever that will induce or whereby intoxication may be produced.

Section 2. Every person who shall be guilty of a violation of the preceding section shall on conviction before the Recorder be fined any sum not less than twenty nor more than fifty dollars or imprisoned in the City Jail not less than five or more than twenty days for each and every such offence.

Section 3. This ordinance to take effect and be in force from and after five days after its publication.
