

Ordinance No. 115

An ordinance to amend Section (2) 110 of Ordinance (12) 100, entitled an ordinance relating to the material to be used, and the manner of building Sidewalks and Crosswalks.

Be it ordained by the Common Council of the City of Albany,

Sec. 1. That Section (2) 110 of Ordinance (12) 100, be amended, so as to read as follows.

Sec (2) 110. The crossways to be on red pine, (3) three inches thick and (6) six inches wide, evenly sanded and to be raised on bearings made of red pine not less than (3 x 6) three by six inches, of oval shape, (5) five of such bearings to be under each section of said crossways.

Said crossways to be from (3 x 6) three to six feet wide as the Committee on Street and Public Property may direct.

The edges to be beveled, and a layer of gravel (3) three inches deep, and (3) three feet wide, to spread on each side of said crossways, and to extend the whole length of the same the grade to be raised to a level with the plank.

Sec. 2. This ordinance to be in force from and after five days of its publication.
