

Ordinance No. 128.

§ An Ordinance to prohibit the use of Barbed Wire, or any rough or dangerous material, in the building of fences adjoining the Alleys or Streets of the City of Albany.

Be it Ordained by the Common Council of the City of Albany.

Sec I No person or persons shall use in the building of any fence, adjoining any street or alley, within the Corporate Limit of the City of Albany, any Barbed wire, or other rough or dangerous metallic substance material.

Sec II Any person violating section one of this Ordinance, shall on conviction before the Recorder, be fined in a sum of not less than five, nor more than ten dollars.

Sec III This Ordinance to be in force from, and after five days after its publication.
