

Ordinance No 146.

Ord No. 146 An Ordinance, granting to the Willamette Valley and Coast Railroad Company the right to make certain excavations on First Street and regulating the manner of doing the same.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section 1 That there be and hereby is granted to the Willamette Valley and Coast Railroad Company the right to make certain excavations along First Street in the City of Albany as in this ordinance provided.

Section 2 That the said excavations shall commence at a point in the center line of First Street 100 feet west of the point where the center line of said railroad intersects the center line of said First Street, thence along said center line of First Street in an easterly direction to a point 500 feet east of the place of beginning on said center line of First Street.

Section 3 That the said excavations shall be made as follows: The space excavated shall be 30 feet in width, fifteen feet on each side of the center line of First Street for the distance aforesaid. The slope from the aforesaid point of beginning shall be gradual and uniform to a point directly under the aforesaid center line of said railroad as at present laid out, and from thence shall be gradual and uniform to the point of termination above. The said excavation shall not exceed three feet in depth at the point of the intersection of the center line of First Street with the center line of said railroad.

Section 4 That the said portion of First Street when so excavated shall be rounded from the sides toward the center thereof and gravelled on the surface to a depth of 6 inches and drained so that the same will make a good road and passage way at all seasons of the year: provided that the embankments on each side of said excavations where the same intersect La Fayette Street shall slope gradually and uniformly so as not to obstruct travel on said La Fayette Street on either side of said railroad, all of which shall be done by and at the expense of said Railroad Company.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be

in force from and after its approval by the
Mayor.
