

Ordinance No. 148.

Ord 148 All Ordinance granting unto Amador Andrews and others the right to erect and maintain a System of Electric Lights and Telephones in the City Albany Oregon.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section I. That there be and there is hereby granted ~~and granted~~ unto Amador Andrews and his associates and unto their heirs, executors, Administrators and assigns the right or franchise to erect and maintain in the Streets and Alleys of the City of Albany all such electric light and telephone posts, poles, towers, wires, lines of wires and other fixtures as may be necessary or convenient or maintained for the purpose of carrying on a system of electric lights or telephones in said City. Provided however, that all posts or poles that may be erected pursuant to this Ordinance, shall be neatly dressed and painted; Provided further, that work on such system of electric lights and telephones shall be commenced and reasonable progress made thereon within six months from the approval of the ordinance by the Mayor of said City.

Section II. The said granters of said right or franchise hereby granted, their successors and assigns, shall erect such posts, poles, and towers, and stretch such wires and lines of wires thereon in such manner as not to interfere with the free and unobstructed use of the Streets and alleys for travel, and at such height as may be designated by the Mayor and Common Council of said City; and the wire and lines of wires shall be stretched at such height as may be designated by said Mayor and Common Council.

Section III. Whenever it shall become necessary in the erection of such posts, poles or towers, to in any manner to interfere with any street or alley, said granters their successors and assigns, shall without delay put such street or alley in as good condition as it was before it was broken up or disturbed, and shall remove all surplus sand earth rubbish or material from such street or alley.

Section IV. The said City of Albany hereby reserves the right to alter change or modify this ordinance or any

of its provisions: to regulate the rates of charges for the use of such electric light or telephone system and to require said grantees their successors or assigns, at any time when it may be deemed necessary to bury all wires or lines of wire used for the purpose of any electric light or telephone.

Section V: Immediately upon the giving of a fire alarm the electric light shall be shut off and so kept until the fire is over and all danger pass.

Section VI: Within thirty days after the approval of this ordinance by the Mayor, the said Amador Andrews and his associates or their authorized agent, shall file in the city records their written acceptance of the conditions and provisions of this ordinance.

Section VII: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor and the written acceptance of its provisions by the said Amador Andrews and his associates, or the agent
