An Ordinance to amend Section 3 of An Ordinance, entitled, "An Ordinance to provide for the time and manner of constructing a sewer in Railroad Street, commencing at a point  $67\frac{3}{10}$  feet south  $168\frac{5}{10}$  W. of the south west corner of a brick warehouse belonging to the estate of G. L. Cowan, deceased and running thence  $20^{\circ}$  East 150 feet, to a point 16 feet from the center of Railroad Street and extending along Railroad Street to the north line of Eighth Street.

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain as follows:

Section I. That Section 3, of an Ordinance entitled, "An Ordinance to provide for the time and manner of constructing a sewer in Railroad Street, commencing at a point  $67\frac{3}{10}$  feet south  $168\frac{5}{10}$  W. of the Southwest corner of a brick warehouse belonging to the estate of G. L. Cowan deceased, and running thence  $20^{\circ}$  east 150 feet to a point 16 feet from the center of Railroad Street and extending along Railroad Street to the north line of Eighth Street, be so amended as to read as follows:

Section I. The Sewer improvements herein provided for shall consist of putting in a sewer of terra cotta or cement pipe or brick of thirty (30) inches of inside diameter, with catch basins, manholes, lamp holes, pockets and branches at such points as the Committee on Streets and Public Property and the Street Commissioner may designate; the work to be done and the

Materials ~~shall~~ furnished in accordance with the plans and specifications for a sewer in Railroad Street commencing at a point 67  $\frac{3}{10}$  feet south, 168  $\frac{5}{10}$  ft of the southwest corner of a brick warehouse belonging to the estate of C. L. Cowan deceased, and running thence 20° East 150 feet to a point 16 feet from the center of Railroad Street, and extending along Railroad Street to the north line of Eighth Street, to be prepared by the City Surveyor and filed in the office of the City Recorder, before bids for commencing the construction of said sewer are invited.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its approval by the mayor.

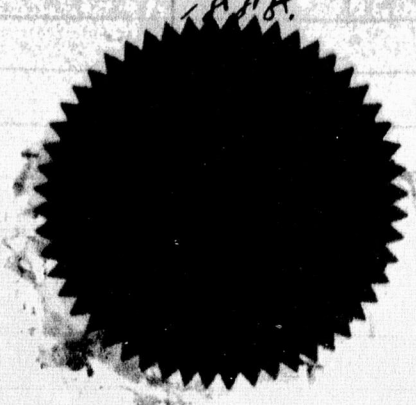

The People of the City of Albany do  
ordain as follows:

Section 1. That Sections One (1) and Three (3) of "an  
Ordinance relating to the establishing  
grade of Streets in the City of Albany" passed  
by the Common Council December 14<sup>th</sup>  
1876, be so amended as to read as  
follows:

Section 1. The established grade of the Streets of  
Albany Linn County Oregon shall be  
in conformity to the survey and plat  
made by Surveyor Warner in 1876 and  
now on file in the office of the  
Recorder of the City of Albany: except
