Ordinance No 186.

An Ordinance to amend Section One (1) of Ordinance No. 165 entitled an Ordinance relating to the material to be used in, and the manner of building sidewalks and Crosswalks, passed by the Council September 13th 1897.

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain as follows:

Section 1 That section one (1) of an Ordinance entitled, "an Ordinance relating to the material to be used in and the manner of building sidewalks and Crosswalks" passed by the Council September 13th 1897 be amended so as to read as follows:

Section 1 That if not otherwise provided for by the City Council, all sidewalks from the south line of First Street to the south line of Third Street between the west line of Baker Street ^{and the west line of Washington Street} in the City of Albany shall be (10) ten feet wide, and all sidewalks from the south line of Third Street, to the south line of Fifth Street, between the west line of Washington Street and the east line of Baker Street in the City of Albany shall be (8) eight feet wide, and shall be constructed as follows: to wit: There shall be five bearings four inches thick by four inches wide, laid on the ground or other suitable support, under each section of stringers, at equal distances apart; there shall be laid on said bearings four tiers of

Stringers, to be three inches thick by four inches wide, and eighteen feet long of red or yellow fir, said stringers to be placed on the hearings at suitable and equal distances apart, and well secured by being nailed to the hearings with thirty penny nails; the decking to be one and a half inch plank, square edged and evenly sawed, and not more than eight inches nor less than four inches wide, to be evenly and closely fitted and well nailed to the stringers with twelve penny nails, all to be done in a good workman like manner, the incline of the walk to be not more than two inches to six feet running measure.

Section II. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section III. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force, from and after its approval by the Mayor.
